Appointed as Executive Director in December 2008, Joanne Slotnik directs the work of the 13-member Judicial Performance Evaluation Commission, statutorily-charged with implementing a comprehensive statewide program of judicial performance evaluation. She came to that position after 16 years of prosecuting criminal appeals in the Utah Attorney General's Office and five years of serving as Utah's first Judicial Education Director in the Administrative Office of the Courts. She also served as a law clerk in both the Utah Supreme Court, for Justice Michael Zimmerman, and the Tenth Circuit Court of Appeals, for Judge Stephen Anderson. Prior to her career in law, Joanne taught in the Salt Lake City School District, where she was one of the founders of the Open Classroom Program.
