With management folders, you can drag and drop assigned information as you go, so when your research is complete it's already organized. You can also visit research history and store personal notes along with your research.

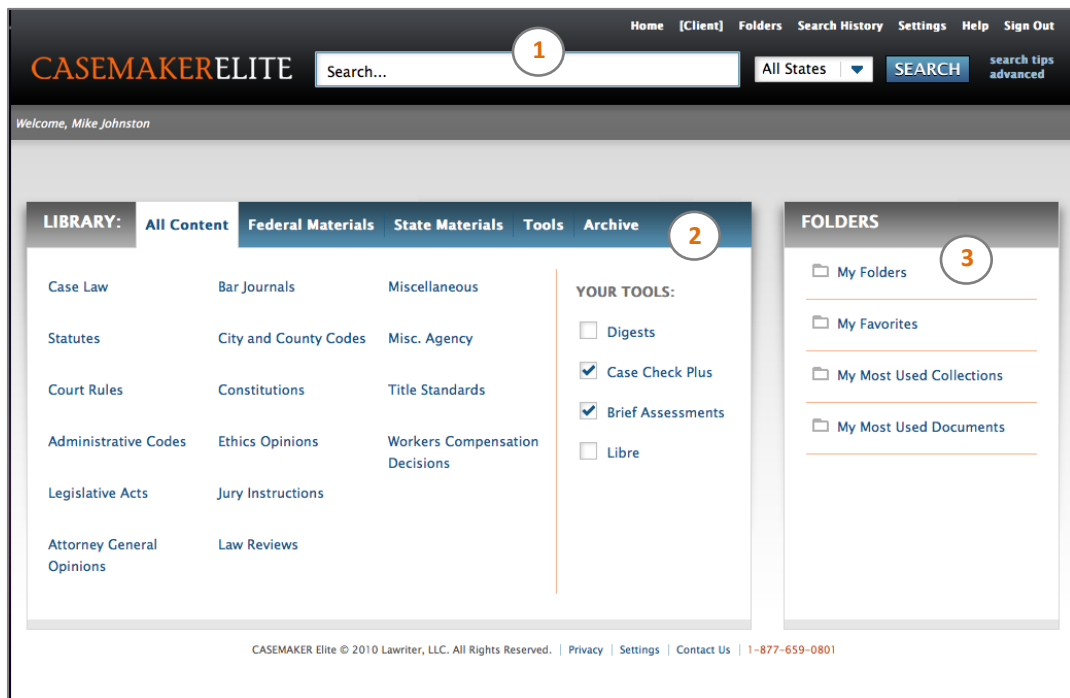
### Intuitive

① – Intuitive: search by citation, string of citations, term, court, name, phrase; combine jurisdictions: state with state, state with federal.

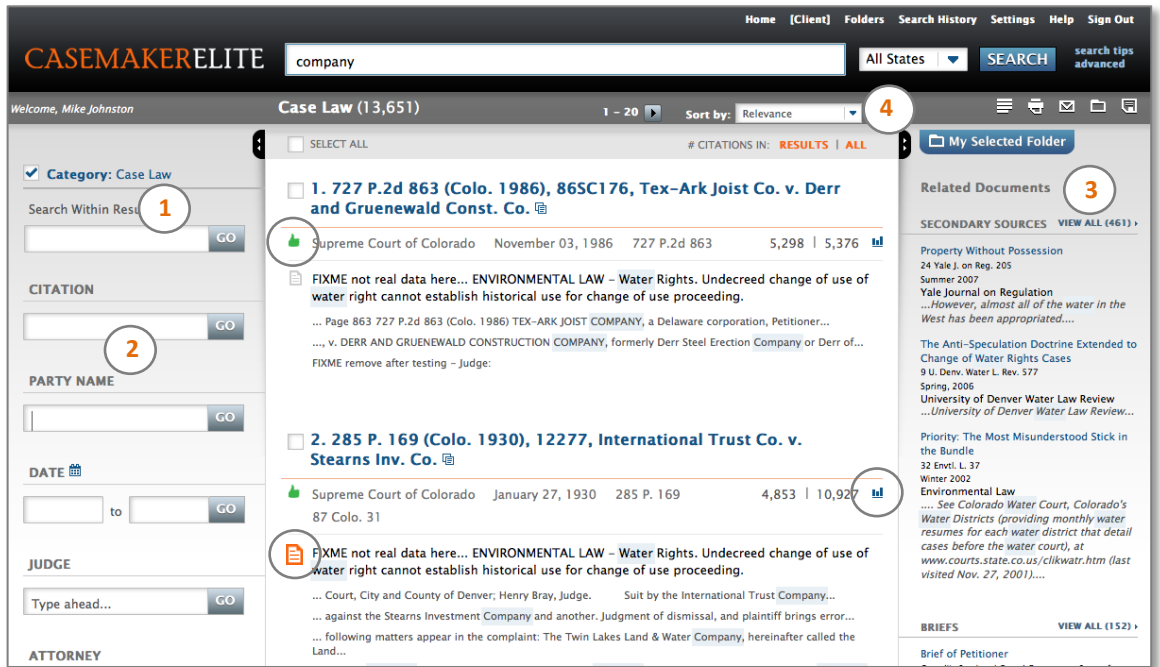
② – Easy to find favorite sources and tools.

③ – Organize cases, text, notes into file folders; access archives of your favorite searches; most used collections.



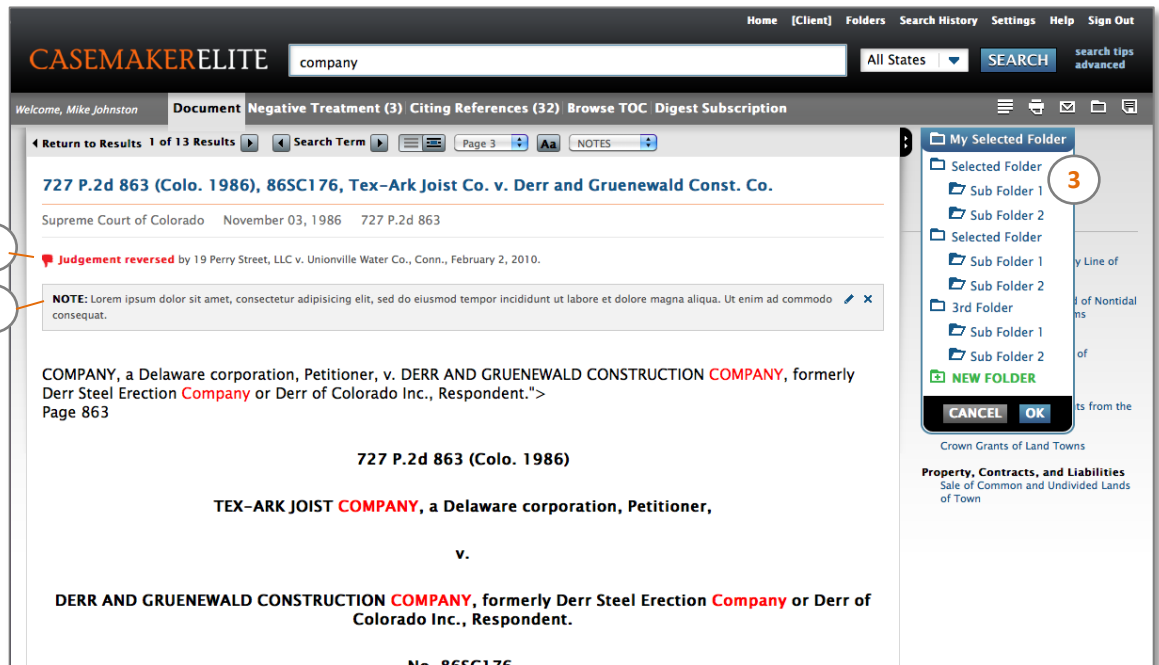
Google-like Research – if you can think it, we can help find it.

- ① – Search Within a Search – continue to narrow within your data set.
- ② – Faceted Search: search fields change based on search jurisdiction and category for most relevancy.
- ③ Positive/Negative Treatment citator.
- ④ Case Summaries available.
- ⑤ – Related Documents: books; chapters; CLE materials; journals; briefs... directly related to your search query.
- ⑥ – Sort by Relevancy; Date; Most Cited; Most Used
- ⑦ - Chart citations by date



Case View

- ① – Negative Treatment.
- ② – Personalized notes
- ③ – Save case, notes, cites, statutes in personalized file folder (just drag & drop).
