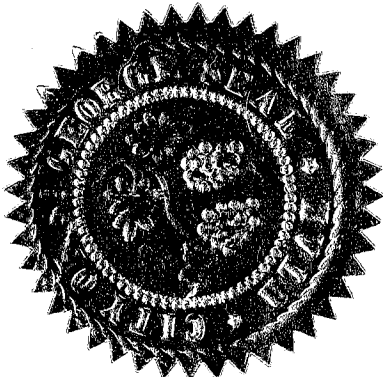
*WHEREAS*, at this event volunteer attorneys will be providing police officers, firefighters and paramedics and their families with wills and other estate planning documents, free of charge.


