Besides signing up for the twice-monthly clinic, three of the firm’s attorneys, Bill Frazier, Jake Graff and Lane Wood often took shifts when other attorneys had conflicts or emergencies. In one instance, Wood made a “house call” when the client couldn’t come to the Center due to a medical issue.
