State Supreme Court Practices within the Circuit

Colorado

Colorado runs live (streamed) video of arguments and both audio and video (via YouTube) is available on the website. Whenever possible, the court also live-streams from schools or remote locations.

Oklahoma

The Supreme Court of Oklahoma has live streamed video via YouTube (as recently as August of 2017 for certain high profile cases) but it does not appear that is a regular practice. Also, it does not appear the OCCA posts audio or video.

New Mexico

In July of 2017, the New Mexico Supreme Court began posting video recordings of all oral argument hearings on the website. It does appear the Court uses video or live-streams.

Wyoming

The Wyoming Supreme Court broadcasts live audio (only) of oral argument hearings.

Utah

The Utah Supreme Court live-streams video of oral arguments. In addition, the audio from past arguments is available on the website dating back to 2004.

Kansas

The Kansas Supreme Court live-streams video for oral argument hearings via YouTube. Audio of argument hearings is available on the website dating back to 2004. It appears video became available starting in late 2012.
