In light of the recent advice of the CDC in discouraging gatherings of large groups to prevent the spread of COVID-19, the Bar Commission has reluctantly decided that the Spring Convention in St. George should be cancelled. The Judicial Council (which holds its meetings in conjunction with our Spring Convention) earlier cancelled its meetings in St. George this week and it seemed wise for us to do the same.

We truly regret to have to take this drastic step at the last minute and know how inconvenient it will be for you. We feel compelled to follow the CDC's guidance in canceling the event, despite the relative low risk still in Utah. The Utah State Bar's concern for the health and wellbeing of our members and their families is of great importance and we feel that our concern for you should prevail in light of today's rapidly changed circumstances. The Bar's decision to cancel the Spring Convention was based on our sincere efforts to facilitate that wellbeing.

The Bar will refund your registration fees and will continue to develop quality CLE opportunities for you in the weeks to come. Thank you for your support.
